Students Earn Internet Business Associate Certification

Certified Internet Webmaster (CIW) is an industry certification for individuals interested in website design and the internet infrastructure.

Created in the 1990s, CIW is the largest Web education certification program.

Students in Web Design at MCHS have taken the first of three courses in the CIW path, the Internet

Business Associate. IBA covers the careers available in the Internet industry, Internet communication and technology, using multimedia on the web, databases and search engines, business email, antivirus and security protocols, and a variety of internet services and tools for business. Project management is also a large part of the exam, as it is in

the real world of website creation.

The six students who passed the exam were Hayze Bowen, Tristan Brown, Jacob Cheaves, Carson King, Gus Marcum and Adain Starks.

The students will next tackle the Site Development Associate course and exam. In SDA, students will do more handson coding of HTML, CSS

and JavaScript to create websites that are ADA and W3C compliant. The final course will be the Network Technology Associate, where the students will study the infrastructure of the network in more detail.

Web Design is a course taught by Lisa Forsythe, and includes both first and second year students.

Freshmen and Seniors are dismissed

Beginning with the graduating class of 2018, studens enrolled in Tennessee public schools during their eleventh grade year must complete the ACT or SAT prior to graduation. This is a requirement for the student to be eligible for graduation.

The statewide testing day for juniors will be Tuesday, March 19. Sophomores will also take a practice ACT on that day. Students should be at school no later than 7:45. They will be free to leave if they have transportation when the test ends, around noon. Students who do not have transportation will stay until the buses run at regular time. Students may bring a calculator, or borrow one from the school, and will need their school ID or driver's license.
