CLASSROOM POLICIES

Students must use a pencil. Papers completed in ink will not be accepted and the student will earn a grade of 0.

Students are to take notes and keep all work organized in a 1" hard backed 3 ring binder. Notebooks are checked regularly and count as a test grade.

Students must show on their papers all work supporting their answer. Papers that do not show work will not be graded and the student will earn a grade of 0.

Cheating will not be tolerated. Students will receive a 0 for copying and/or giving away answers.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

1. Bring paper, pencils, notebook, and textbook to class each day.
2. Be in your assigned seat when the tone sounds.
3. Respect others and their property. (Keep hands to yourself. Do not mark on walls, desk, boards, etc. Disrespectful comments will not be tolerated.)
4. Listen when others are speaking. (No talking during class instruction time.)
5. Participate in all classroom activities. (Stay alert and do your work. Sleeping in class will not be tolerated.)
6. Food, drink, gum, and candy are not allowed.
7. Follow instructions the first time. (Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that is not disruptive to the class.)

POSITIVE REWARDS

Verbal praise, contact with parent, individual and group privileges.

CONSEQUENCES

1. First Offense - Verbal warning and documentation.
2. Second offense – Intervention along with documentation.
3. Third offense – 500 word handwritten report on a famous mathematician assigned and documentation.
4. Fourth offense – Office disciplinary referral and documentation.

SEVERE CLAUSE

Students will be sent to the office immediately for behavior including, but not limited to, fighting, continued misbehavior, the use of profanity, or any other severe behavior.
