PHILOSOPHY

The teacher will teach and each student will have the opportunity to learn.

Any behavior which interferes with the teacher's attempt to teach or any student's opportunity to learn will not be tolerated.

EXPECTATIONS

To maintain an environment which supports teaching and learning, these conditions must exist

Preparation

Participation

Rules:

1. Be on time. Anyone *not* in his/her seat when the bell rings will be considered tardy.
2. Be on task. Failure to do *regular* work will result in *extra* work.
3. Be prepared. Come to class with notebook, pen/pencil, etc.
4. Be respectful—of the teacher and the other students in class. If you don't have anything nice to say don't say anything at all. (This includes refraining from remarks that are vulgar, obscene, etc. These have no place in the classroom).
5. Be alert. You won't know what is going on if you're asleep or not paying attention.

PROCEDURES*

Arrival	Come in. Sit down. Prepare for class (bellwork first).
Bellwork	At tardy tone, follow instructions on "Bellwork" board.
Cell phones, etc.	School policy (posted in classroom), strictly enforced.
Cheating	Penalty for cheating (including plagiarism) is a grade of 0.
Computer	Valid ID required. Permission required. No games, email.
Deadlines	Deadlines are absolute. (Yes, I'm talking about research papers here).
Dismissal	The teacher (not the tone) dismisses the class.
Field Trips	Permission granted if specified conditions are met.
Food, Drink	No food. Drinks allowed if no distraction and when Chromebooks are NOT being used. Trash results in loss of privilege.
Labels	All work will be labeled with NAME, DATE, BLOCK.
Late Work	Late work will be accepted by 8:00 AM the following morning (-20 pts.). After that it will not be accepted.
Make-up Work	Student's responsibility. You must come to me or look on the assignment board next to the bookshelf.
Materials	Notebook, text/novel, assignment, pen/pencil in class daily. No return to locker.

Notebook	Three ring binder with four tabbed sections. Papers filed in appropriate sections.
Passes	You will receive 3 opportunities per nine weeks to leave the room with your personal agenda. Use these wisely. *Students may not save passes for the next quarter.
Pens	Blue or black ink only.
Progress Report	Upon parent request only.
Tardiness	Unacceptable. Do not be late; be in your seat. 4th tardy results in office referral.

Positive Outcomes: Free time, Quiz Pass, Movie, Food

Consequences:

1. Warning
2. Extra Work—write offs or extra article summaries/ parental contact (Anything the teacher deems necessary).
3. Office Referral
